

Psalm 22:15		John 19:28 (NIV) Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty."
Psalm 22:18		John 19:23–24 (NIV) When the soldiers crucified Jesus, they took his clothes, dividing them into four shares, one for each of them, with the undergarment remaining. This garment was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom. "Let's not tear it," they said to one another. "Let's decide by lot who will get it."
Psalm 22:16		John 19:18 There they crucified him, and with him two others, one on either side, and Jesus between them.
