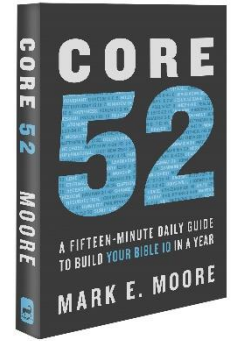


CORE 52 SERMON SERIES



OPTION 1: For churches who desire to align their preaching and small group material, Core52 provides suggested series that move through the book in canonical order.

- (1) ***Can we alter the sermon series titles or even shift some texts that we feel would fit better?***
Yes. This program has expandable edges, if you will, to allow for flexibility for various congregational needs. In fact, the sermons could focus on either the core verse or on the suggested story, which are thematically tied to the core verse.
- (2) ***What if we need to insert a different series?*** That's expected. If your church is in a building campaign, a leadership transition, or need to address a cultural issue, there are core verses that could be shifted to address those specific needs OR the sermon series could break away from the small group material for a few weeks and then realign afterward.

Series Descriptions:

Beginnings: Virtually every major question of life is asked and answered in the first book of the Bible. Why are we here? Who am I? What went wrong? And how can we get right with God? This is not just good theology, it is critical philosophy for every human being.

Set Apart: We all want to feel special. We love being chosen; we need to feel valued. This series explores what God looks for in the people he chooses and how you can be part of his inner circle. The biographies of Moses, Saul, and David offer strategic insights for your best life.

Singing the Sacred: In the center of the bible is the book of songs. They cover a wide range of styles, moods, moments, and even instruments because they are the soundtrack of our spiritual lives. Embedded in these songs are some of the deepest truths AND some of the highest promises pointing to Jesus.

Hidden Hope: The entire Bible is about Jesus. Sometimes he sits on the surface of the page. Other times Jesus hides between the lines. This four-week series explores some of these hidden gems that shine brightest when Jesus is brought to light.

Apex: The Sermon on the Mount is the most influential speech in human history with no close second. Multiple times in this single speech Jesus dropped a bomb shell that altered religious thought. Each week we will look at one of those revolutionary statements that literally changed the course of history.

Bottom Line: Matthew was an accountant—he brokered in bottom lines. He, of all people, snapped to attention when Jesus threw down the gauntlet of his identity, our election, ultimate realities, and global mission. Bottom line: If you want to follow Jesus, you have to settle accounts here.

A Beginner's Guide to Greatness: Mark was the youngest biographer of Jesus who had a string of failures in his ministry resume. But he never quit so that by the end of his life both Peter and Paul considered him a spiritual son. That's why his gospel is such a valuable guide as a "Beginner's Guide to Greatness." He embedded Jesus' best advice on how to achieve success in life.

Eagle's Eye: In Classical Christian Art, the Gospel of John is depicted with the symbol of an Eagle. Why? Because his theology is lofty. He flies closer to the Son. We are going to look at a handful of those "lofty thoughts" that will lift you out of the mundane to new heights.

Outside In: Luke is the only non-Jewish author of the Bible. If you have ever known sting of being on the outside, his perspective will bring fresh wind to your spiritual journey. You can walk with Luke from the perimeter, to the very heart of God.

Beyond Belief: There are some things that even Christians have a hard time believing. If you can believe it, you can receive it: Freedom from guilt, freedom to change, freedom to know God's thoughts. Ultimately, we are promised the freedom from this body through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Believe it.

One Thing: Paul was a world traveler and premier teacher. Yet he had a remarkable ability to reduce the most complicated ideas into to a singular truth that you can put in your pocket and take with you. Here are some of his singular truths that will make a world of difference.

Look: Your legacy has a lot to do with your vantage point. What you pay attention to will get your attention. What gets your attention will determine your direction. Your direction will determine your destination. Your destination determines your legacy. So look.

OPTION 2: This is the best option for churches who want to align the annual calendar of the church with the material of Core52. Here are some of the common question:

- (1) ***Does it diminish the impact of Core52 if we do not go through it in the same order as the book?*** No. The book is arranged from Genesis to Revelation but each chapter is a stand-alone and can be consumed in any order.
- (2) ***Should we begin this series in January?*** Not necessarily, however, it is laid out with sensitivity to the calendar so starting at another time might require shifting some of the series.

Series Descriptions:

Your Best You: As we kick off a new year, we tend to be more open to healthy habits. These six practices could potentially reroute the trajectory of your year. Think of this as your spiritual health club membership.

I Love My Church: Have you ever wondered why we do what we do when we gather together? Our church services are no mere modern inventions. We are following in ancient and noble traditions laid out in sacred Scripture. Though we worship in ways that are culturally relevant, we are connected to the church universal in ways that are spiritually significant.

Living It: It is not enough to say we believe in Jesus. We need to put feet to our faith. We are going to circle the wagons around the core of Christianity and ask how to live it out where we live our lives.

New Lens: No one really denies that we now live in a Post-Christian nation. The foundations of faith have been eroded. This provides a significant advantage to people of faith when we live a counter-cultural life BUT only if we stand securely on a Christian Worldview revealed in Scripture.

Getting Right with God: What does it take to have a genuine and real relationship with your creator? The Bible addresses this head on. You CAN know God. You can live in his presence and with his power. Here's how.
